Certified sustainable through Lodi Rules for Sustainable Wine Growing, Twisted Cedar wines reflect a commitment to quality wine and responsible stewardship. The Twisted Cedar name honors the Cedar Band, one of 5 Bands of the Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah, named after the cedar tree that heavily populated their land. Dedicated to being good stewards for Mother Earth, these fine wines are a tribute to a proud people.
