Vineyard:

A mild climate (due to the Atlantic Ocean). Lots of sunshine, and regular rain, the hillside situation and the clay-limestone soil, gravels offer the best conditions for the growth of the vines and the grapes.

Vinification:

Vinified in stainless steel thermos-regulated vats, with 30% of the wine aged in oak.

Terroir:

Clayey-Calcareous

Training system:

The vineyard is held up by Guyot double (Bordeaux style) to obtain the best maturity and also to avoid phytosanitary disease. The vine is held up by wires

Tasting Notes:

Deep purples color. Intense aromas of black fruits, spices and oaky vanilla. Great balance and length.

Bordeaux has always had Malbec in its vineyards although it is rare. This unusual wine shows how, in a fruity year, the grape can work well. The tannins are soft, giving a juicy black-fruited wine that is forward and delicious to drink now for its succulent fruit.
