

BARCELONA, SPAIN

Barcelona is a city of contrast with the ever-present whimsical architecture of Antoni Gaudí tossed in to delight the visitor. Fabulous architecture, world class museums, fashionable shopping and fine cuisine – Barcelona provides this and more to the visitor.

CASABLANCA, MOROCCO

Forever immortalized by the classic movie of the same name, Casablanca is Morocco's modern metropolis. Everything is bigger here: the streets, the hotels, the office blocks and the slums. The people themselves say that; "Casablanca has no memory and no past, only a future." A rich heritage of Art Deco architecture fused with North African elements acts as a tangible reminder of the city's French colonial past. Alternatively, a full day excursion to Marrekesh is a delightful experience.

GENOA, ITALY

Genoa is a leading Italian port, university town and a major commercial center. Its history dates back to 218 BC. when the city was founded by the Ligurians. Today, the old town boasts narrow, busy streets with a typical Mediterranean ambiance, while the new town features modern buildings, gardens and villas.

LISBON, PORTUGAL

Portugal's capital is an 18th-century city - elegant, open to the sea and carefully planned. Most places of interest are within easy walking distance. Rossio Square, the heart of Lisbon since medieval times, is an ideal place to start exploring. Many rebuilt houses with original façades provide stores and restaurants with modern interiors. High above Baixa is Bairro Alto - with its teeming nightlife. There are many monuments and museums, such as San Jeronimos Monastery, Royal Coach Museum and Gulbenkian Museum. Two well-known landmarks are the Monument to the Discoveries and the Tower of Belem. A statue of Christ

looms above Europe's longest suspension bridge.

MALAGA, SPAIN

Malaga is perfectly situated in the heart of Spain's famous Costa del Sol. The Moors occupied this area of Spain for eight centuries and their influence is seen in the architecture, folklore and native costumes. The city is known as the birthplace of Pablo Picasso, and for the sweet Malaga dessert wines that come from the hilly vineyards.

MARSEILLE, FRANCE

Marseille: A delightful blend of history, outstanding seafood, culture and heritage. France's second largest city and the capital of the Provence- Côte d'Azur region, the cosmopolitan city of Marseille lies on the southeast coast. Although Marseille is the economic and industrial capital of France, it manages to remain true to its own traditions and culture, reflected in the Marseille way of life and its numerous museums, theatres and opera houses.
